Do you need help paying for child care?





Visit www.chs-ca.org or call (714) 543-2273 Children's Home Society of California (CHS) and the Orange County Department of Education (OCDE) offer subsidized child care programs to help pay for most or all of your child care expenses. You may select a child care provider that meets the needs of your family, such as a licensed home or center, or a friend or family member.

Families with children birth through 12 years old may be eligible if you meet income requirements and have a qualifying need for child care. Your eligibility is based on your gross monthly income and is adjusted for your family size.

Income Requirements:

Family Size	Maximum Gross Monthly Income
1-2	\$6,008
3	\$6,842
4	\$7,941
5	\$9,211

Qualifying Needs:

- working or attending school
- seeking employment
- experiencing homelessness
- incapacitated
- the child is deemed at risk of abuse or neglect by a legally qualified professional and/or is receiving Child Protective Services (requires referral)
